HEALTH: All animals are eligible for interstate shipment. Interstate health papers prepared by an accredited veterinarian will be furnished on each animal sold. of 21 #1 eggs per flush. Not to shabby-if you have done any embryo work in the past; you realize how valuable a cow that not only produces eggs but pregnancies is to your program. We have embryo sons and daughter by Silver Bullet 4604P in our weanling pen. We feel they rank right at the top of the pen. When Phil called to say he was going to down size his cowherd by selling all his partnership cows, I was a little shocked. Hi Dee 3021 is not the type of cow you see on the auction block very often (3 years old – proven cow – proven donor).

This phenomenal female is a daughter of Red Angus Royalty -Buffalo Creek Cherokee Canyon 4912. He's a bull that really does everything right – low birth weight, moderate framed, great carcass values. Ranking put him in the top 30% or above for all measured economic traits. Basically, you know your getting from a Cherokee Canyon calf. Maternally, Hi Dee 3021 is out of a Holden Hi Roller 8106 bred cow that traces back to the Bieber Mimi cow family. It is the same cow family that produced the Bieber Make Mimi bull for Accel. Genetics, and Neo Sho Ranch.

Finally, a son of Hi Dee -by Make Mimi topped the 2006 Leachman of Colorado Bull Sale. A partnership of Craig Bieber, and Butch Schuler purchased LCOC High Noon A093R for a winning bid of \$27,000. Look for big things in the future from High Noon as calves are expected at Shamrock, Leachman's, Bieber's, and Schuler's.

That day Hi Dee sold one half interest to long time friend – Phil Case. We've flushed her after she calved as a first calf heifer. 5 times flushed with an average
